

Noise Variance Request

The City of Mukilteo has adopted standard construction work hours that apply to all projects within the City (see [Mukilteo Municipal Code \(MMC\) 9.46.080](#)):

Monday through Friday, 7 AM – 9 PM

Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays, 9 AM – 7 PM

In rare cases, construction activity may need to occur at night or on holidays for construction projects within 500 feet of any location where residents or visitors to Mukilteo sleep (includes uses like residential and mixed uses, overnight accommodations, and overnight medical treatment facilities). A noise variance may be requested under [Chapter 8.18 MMC](#) for special circumstances that are unavoidable or unreasonable during the daytime construction work hours.

Please submit the items on this form with a completed Land Use Application form and review fee to the Permit Center, a minimum of six (6) weeks in advance of the proposed work. Staff will review the application to determine if additional information is needed. Application is not a guarantee that the request will be approved.

SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

1. A noise variance request, including at a minimum:
 - a. A detailed description of the work;
 - b. The proposed dates and times of work;
 - c. The equipment that will be used to complete the work;
 - d. A description of the special circumstances and an explanation of why they are unavoidable or unreasonable;
 - e. An explanation of how the request is the minimum necessary to complete the work;
 - f. Proposed methods to limit noise impacts to adjacent properties; and
 - g. Two (2) 24-hour emergency contacts, including name, title, email address and phone number.
2. A site plan, including at a minimum:
 - a. Date, scale and north arrow;
 - b. Parcel boundaries and street names;
 - c. Project boundaries; and
 - d. The nature of the work.
3. Draft public notification flyer, including at a minimum:
 - a. Description of work;
 - b. Proposed dates and times of work;
 - c. Potential noise impacts on neighboring properties;
 - d. Proposed methods to limit noise impacts;
 - e. Vicinity map with project boundaries;
 - f. Contact information for complaints and project information.
4. An electronic list of all addresses within 500 feet of the project site, including suites and units.

NOTE:

Notice is required to be mailed to impacted properties a minimum of ten (10) calendar days in advance of the work.
